Houston Methodist is seeking patients who have recovered from proven COVID-19 infection to donate their blood plasma. Plasma from a healthy, recovered patient contains antibodies that kill the virus and have the potential to heal and potentially save the life of a hospitalized COVID-19 patient.

- Eligible plasma donors include both Houston Methodist patients with proven COVID-19 infection and patients treated outside of Houston Methodist for COVID-19.
- If treated for COVID-19 outside of Houston Methodist, please provide proof of a positive COVID-19 molecular test result.
- Patients with certain underlying medical conditions and advanced age are not eligible to donate.

The plasma donation procedure is similar to donating blood and takes about an hour.

Unlike regular blood donation, plasma can be donated as often as twice a week.
