

# Collaborating to standardize

## testing amid a large health system merger

### Situation

Two mid-sized regional health systems in the Midwest began a merger during 2018. Upon merger, RFP was issued to various lab vendors seeking to streamline test utilization management and operationalize a single, joint core laboratory:

- 30 hospitals
- 6,659 beds
- 8,533 physicians

The community that these organizations serve has a high incidence of drug misuse and associated death rates.

### Challenges

This health system faced several challenges:

- Medical advisory board lacked the ability to monitor and manage test utilization across the growing organization
- Testing was not standardized, which led to duplicate testing, inconsistent clinical values, and higher patient out-of-pocket costs
- Lacked the ability to develop custom test panels based on the various needs of their patient population



### Solutions

We collaborated with the organizational administrators and laboratory stakeholders to ensure their key needs for test utilization management and test offering were met:

- Provided an analytics and test utilization management offering
- Created testing consistency across the organization by standardizing the source of toxicology testing through a single-source vendor
- Supplied a variety of testing to meet various stakeholder needs and better serve patients, including pain management, primary care, and behavioral health
